The Pickleball Canada National Tournament hosted by Pickleball Kelowna will be skill based and be played **outdoors** on 26 courts. This is a Pickleball Canada sanctioned tournament that will use IFP rules.

Location: Parkinson Recreation Center, 1800 Parkinson Way, Kelowna, B.C., V1Y 4P9

Tournament Information:

- **Early registration** runs from January 1st, 2017 to March 31st, 2017.
- **Early registration fees:** \$40 plus \$10 for each event entered.
- **Regular registration** runs from April 1st, 2017 to June 1st 2017.
- **Regular registration fees:** \$50 plus \$10 for each event entered.
- Players may enter a maximum of 3 events and may only enter one doubles, one mixed doubles and one singles event.
- Registration should be completed online at www.pickleballtournaments.com
- Pickleball Canada members will receive a \$5 discount off the registration fee. When registering online please make sure you enter your membership number in your personal profile to receive the discount. Leave it blank if you are not a member.
- Note that if you are currently not a member of Pickleball Canada Organization (PCO) or your membership expires prior to the completion of the tournament your registration fee will include a PCO 1 year membership.
- Players must be 14 years of age or older any time in 2017 in order to compete—special consideration may be given to experienced younger players.
- Entry fee includes food voucher & tournament shirt.
- Open events limited to skill level 4.5 and up.
- The tournament committee reserves the right to place players in their appropriate skill level category.
- All doubles events will be double elimination with each match being best 2 out of 3 games to 11 on the "A" side of the draw. On the "B" side of the draw each match will consist of one game to 15.
- All singles events will be double elimination with each match being 1 game to 15—gold medal matches will be best 2 out of 3 games to 11.
- Medals will be awarded to the top 3 teams in each division, cash prizes for gold medal winners in Open events.

Events:

- Men's Singles 3.5, 4.0, 4.5, Open—Friday
- Women's Doubles 3.0, 3.5, 4.0, 4.5, Open, Senior Open —Friday
- Mixed Doubles 3.0, 3.5, 4.0, 4.5, Open, Senior Open—Saturday
- Women's Singles 3.5, 4.0, 4.5, Open —Sunday
- Men's Doubles 3.0, 3.5, 4.0, 4.5, Open, Senior Open — Sunday
- Rain Day—Monday, if necessary
